#### Rules of Engagement

Roberts Rules of Orders is used to assist the SMUS Board in ensuring that the planned business of the AGM is completed as efficiently and smoothly as possible, while also giving those who want to participate in the meeting the opportunity to do so.

To further assist in that goal, the following "rules of engagement" will also apply at the AGM:

- 1. Members will ensure their full name plus "Member" appears on Zoom to all other meeting attendees. For example, JANE SMITH MEMBER. You will be unable to attend the AGM unless your full name appears on Zoom.
- 2. Members who wish to speak on any of the Motions presented at the AGM are welcome to do so, however their time to speak will be limited to a maximum of two (2) minutes.
- 3. If other Members wish to speak on the same Motion, those other Members may speak before a Member that has already spoken is permitted to speak again.
- 4. No Member shall be permitted to speak more than twice on the same Motion.
- 5. Members may also speak or ask questions about items of business at the AGM that do not involve Motions. The above rules will also apply.
- 6. Members will stay muted until invited by the Chair to speak.
- 7. Decorum, politeness and courtesy are expected from all attendees.
- 8. Any Member that impugns or attacks the character of another attendee will be immediately removed from the meeting.
- 9. 15 minutes prior to the AGM start time and 15 minutes after the end of the AGM, Members may use the chat function on Zoom to chat with each other (including direct and group messages).





#### Treasurer's Report

On behalf of the Finance Committee and the Board of Governors, I am pleased to report that the school's auditors have once again issued an unqualified report to the financial statements for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2025. A summarized statement of operating revenue and expenditures is included with this report.

The school's strategy is to achieve a balanced annual operating budget where revenues are equal to expenditures, with an appropriate allocation to the reserve fund. In 2025 the transfer to reserve was approximately \$3.5 million (2024: \$3.6 million). For the 2025 fiscal year, there was an overall operating surplus of \$4,711 (2024: \$4,687) after inter-fund transfers.

The school continues to prioritize affordability for all families who choose SMUS. In fiscal 2025, a total of \$2.4 million (2024: \$2.5 million) was made available to families through financial aid and staff bursaries. Financial aid is funded from several sources including endowment funds, Annual Fund, and school operations.

A strong fiscal 2025 is a critical component to meeting the school's goal of providing the highest quality education within a sustainable operating budget going forward. Some specific highlights from fiscal 2025 are:

- The school's financial position remained strong with combined net fund balances of \$56.1 million (2024: \$53.3 million) including \$39.9 million (2024: \$41.2 million) in capital funds at the end of the fiscal year.
- The school's long-term bank debt stands at \$4.1 million (2024: \$3.8 million) with annual debtservicing costs representing 1.1% (2024: 1.7%) of gross operating revenue, which is well within the 10% allowed under the Society's bylaws.
