- One term, August –December 2018
- 2 students from SMUS
- 2 students from Woodstock
- Reciprocal, concurrent homestay or boarding
- Costs: Airfare, tuition, spending money, Study Permit, inoculations, incidentals, (~\$2,500)
- Pre-requisites: good grades, good citizenship

ECUADOR

Colegio Terranova, Quito, Ecuador

- Grades 9-11
- Two-three weeks, February/March 2019
- Students from Ecuador visit Victoria in February 2019
- Students from SMUS visit Ecuador in March 2019
- Up to 10 students, any gender
- Reciprocal, consecutive Homestay program
- Costs: Airfare, study permit (if necessary), spending money, chaperone costs (~\$3,500)



St. Michaels University School

- Pre-requisites: Knowledge about and interest in South America; basic knowledge of Spanish language + good grades, good citizenship

JAPAN

Ikeda Junior High School, Osaka, Japan

- Grade 9 or 10
- February 2019 (flexible term and dates)
- 2-3 students, any gender
- Homestay program
- Costs: Airfare, homestay fees, spending money, Study Permit (if required), refundable \$500 deposit (~\$2,500)
- Pre-requisites: Knowledge about and interest in Japan; basic knowledge of Japanese language + good grades, good citizenship

QUEBEC

Collège Ste. Anne, Montréal, Québec

- Grades 9-11
- One month program
- Reciprocal, consecutive homestay
- 2 students, any gender
- SMUS students travel to Quebec in January 2019
- Quebec students visit SMUS in Jan/Feb 2019
- Pre-requisites: good grades, good citizenship, interest in Quebec history and culture, intermediate French skills
- Costs: Travel Scholarship, spending money and hosting only

FRANCE, SPAIN, BELGIUM

Arranged in partnership with **OSEF** (www.osef.ca)

- Ages 13-17
- 4 week option: July/August 2018
- 11 week option: Aug-Nov 2018 & Feb.-April 2019
- Any gender, unlimited number
- Reciprocal, Consecutive Homestay
- Cost: ~\$4,290 (does not include airfare)
- Deadline to apply: end of May 2018

CHINA

In development; various options such as Zhengzhou, Hangzhou, Shanghai

- Grades 9-11
- Any gender, 2-4 students, 3-4 weeks
- Homestay with local family
- Cost: ~\$2,000 (airfare + chaperone expenses)
